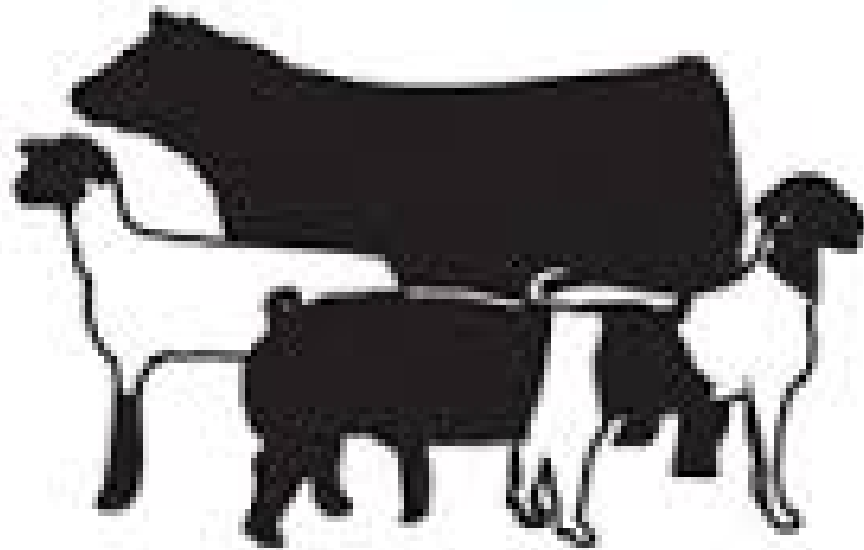

Junior Livestock and Indoor Exhibits Committees Job Descriptions

Grievance Committee: The Grievance Committee will review all written complaints, protest that are properly followed in the protest section. They will apply all of the General Rules, Junior Livestock Rules & Regulations, Special Rules, and Indoor Exhibits Rules & Regulations to the protest submitted and will act and make a final decision of a said grievance. The committee will consist of the Junior Livestock Coordinator and Superintendents.

Indoor Exhibits Committee: Thee Indoor Exhibits Committee will request for showcases, tables and chairs from the Fair Office. The committee will contact judges to judge the exhibit items and indoor activities. They will be responsible for decorating, maintaining and keeping the exhibit area neat and clean. They will coordinate entries and premium pay-outs. The committee members will be scheduled throughout the fair to maintain and to inform the public about 4-H projects and activities.

Horsemanship Committee: The Horsemanship Committee will be responsible for setting up the arena and obstacles to be used in the Horse Show. They will coordinate the event schedule.

Auction Sales Committee: The Auction Sales Committee will coordinate the Junior Livestock Sale and he Pay-outs. They will welcome each buyer when they arrive to the livestock pavilion.

Livestock Check-Out & Release Committee: The Livestock Check-Out & Release Committee will organize all of the needed paperwork for proper check-out and release of each livestock exhibit. The committee will consist of Junior Livestock Superintendents.

Campsite Committee: There will be an additional fee for camping. Camping fee is due on the first day of event. Cash only. Contact program coordinator for fee info.

Buyers Luncheon/ Cook Out Committee: The Cook Out Committee will plan a menu and solicit for the food and supplies to be used for the cook out. They will prepare, set up, decorate, serve and clean up the cook out area. The committee will provide coffee and/or refreshments for the workers and for the buyers during the Junior Livestock Auction.

Wooly Ride Committee: The Wooly Ride Committee will be responsible for obtaining and/or building the chutes. They will contact a stock contractor, solicit and/or request for donations for awards and coordinate the entries.

Liability: The 4-H/FFA Junior Livestock Show & Sale and Indoor Exhibit Committee and staff, Navajo Nation Fair & its Committee will not be responsible for any accidents, injury and/or loss to any and all livestock, indoor exhibits, exhibitors, and/or parents. Exhibitors are recommended to carry their own liability insurance. The Judges and the Grievance Committee reserve the right to disqualify and excuse any animal from all entry and competition due to dangerous behavior and sickness and/or lameness.

The 4H/FFA Junior Livestock Show & Sale and Indoor Exhibits Committee and staff, Navajo Nation Fair Committee will not be responsible for any livestock and indoor exhibits left of the fairgrounds after the close of the fair.

2018 NAVAJO NATION FAIR INDOOR EXHIBITS RULES & REGULATIONS

PURPOSE: The 4-H/FFA Indoor Exhibits offers home arts ranging from Cooking and Sewing to Electricity and Welding made by members of 4-H Clubs and students of Future Farmers of America (FFA) to encourage and establish a practical interest among people to be self-sufficient.

Exhibitors, parents, 4-H leaders and sponsors are required to familiarize themselves with all of the Rules & Regulations of the Indoor Exhibits Department.

ENTRY DEADLINE: * August 17, 2018, 5:00 PM.

PRE-REGISTRATION/ENTRY FORMS: All Indoor Exhibits shall be entered on a **Pre-Registration/Entry Form with CORRECT LOT NUMBERS for each item entered.** All entries must be mailed in, postmarked, or hand delivered by the deadline date, to the Cooperative Extension 4-H Office located on the Navajo Nation Fairgrounds in Window Rock, Arizona. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**

Pre-Registration/Entry forms can be obtained at the Cooperative Extension 4-H Office located on the Navajo Nation Fairgrounds in Window Rock, Arizona, or use the attached Indoor Exhibits Entry Form.

ENTRY LIMIT: Exhibitors can enter only five (5) exhibits W/Correct Lot Numbers in this division (which includes Public Speaking, Demonstration, Talent, and Fashion Show). Each exhibit entered must be under one (1) class, except Class 33 which may enter up to 3 lots.

***Exhibitor/Participants must have performed or attended two local or area workshop or learning sessions of these particular projects (public speaking, demonstration, talent and fashion review) to be eligible to enter class 40, 41, 42 & 43. Project(s) must be signed off by instructor and documented in record book.**

Only the Indoor Exhibits listed on the premium list and those that the exhibitor had registered the enrollment form will be judged.

CHECK-IN: September 5, 2018, from 2:00 PM to 7:00 PM. All Indoor Exhibits entered must be checked in at this time.

JUDGING: September 5, 2018, from 2:00PM to 8:00 PM. All Indoor Exhibit will be judged at this time.

OWNERSHIP: Exhibits entered must have been carried as 4-H, F.F.A., or F.H.A. projects by the exhibitor during the **present club year and must be the work of the exhibitor, Record books must be provided. All project entries will be verified before entry is accepted.**

Tape or staple the label giving the exhibitor's name, address, 4-H Club, age of 4-H'er and the year of the project on the article.

All baked goods and vegetables on the plate must have three (3) items. Use ziplock freezer storage bags for food items. If not complied with this rule, the entries will be disqualified.

All sewing items must be neatly pressed and brought on a hanger.

Fashion Revue: A description card for clothing to be modeled is due at the check-in time on September 5, 2018.

All flower arrangements must be in a vase and all potted plants must have been grown by the exhibitor. Record sheets will be requested at random for all In-door Exhibits.

All Indoor Exhibits will be judged using Danish System and the premiums will be paid as follows:

Blue Ribbon - \$5.00

Red Ribbon - \$3.00

White Ribbon - \$2.00

Best of Show

Vegetable & Garden- \$15.00

Baking- \$15.00

Sewing- \$15.00

The judge will not award ribbons unless the articles are deemed worthy of merit. Superintendents will disqualify any exhibits before judging that are not entered according to the Indoor Exhibits Rules & Regulations and/or do not meet the project requirements.

Exhibitors are allowed to enter only one (1) speech, one (1) demonstration, one (1) talent and one (1) fashion show. (DESCRIPTION OF FASHION SHOW SHOULD ACCOMPANY SUMMARY FORM. USE FORM INCLUDED IN THIS PREMIUM BOOK.)

Judges will be allowed to ask questions of each contestant on speech and demonstration.

TIME LIMITS: The time limits for Public Speaking, Demonstrations and Talents are as follows:

Novice : 1-3 minutes

Junior : 3-5 minutes

Senior : 5-7 minutes

The minimum time is suggested, but the maximum time limit will be enforced.

All public speaking, demonstrators, talents and fashion show will be judged using the American System and the premiums will be paid as follows: **Note, * Special Rules Apply, see rule # 4.**

1st place - \$30.00 - Group \$20.00 - Individual

2nd place - \$20.00 - Group \$15.00 - Individual

3rd place - \$10.00 - Group \$10.00 - Individual

4th place - \$ 8.00 - Group \$ 6.00 - Individual

5th place - \$ 6.00 - Group \$ 4.00 - Individual

6th place - \$ 4.00 - Group \$ 2.00 - Individual

****Boosters will be allowed to show items and will receive only a participation award. They will not be judged and will not be allowed to claim premiums.****

Class 44 (4-H Club Booth): Feature Exhibits Booth. It provides members an opportunity to acquaint the public with a specific phase of their club program. Feature Booth is limited to one(1)entry by a club. Booths must be designed, constructed and installed by the members. Leaders may supervise only. Entry Forms must be signed by a member of the club and by a leader. **Booths will be 3 ft. deep by 6 ft. Wide.** The Indoor Exhibits Committee will position the booths.

AGE CLASSIFICATION:

Novice : (9-11 years old)

Junior : (12-13 years old)

Senior : (14-19 years old)

Awards for Hi-Point Boy/Girl in each age division of novice, junior and senior will be awarded.

RELEASE: All Indoor Exhibits must be claimed until after 11:00 AM on September 9,2018. Early release will only be granted to the exhibitors whom have requested for early released of Junior Livestock and/or Indoor Exhibits to attend another fair directly after the Navajo Nation Fair. (Refer to Rule #24/Early Release-General Rules.)

Exhibitors and/or parties representing the exhibitor must and will be responsible for **collecting their projects at the close of the fair**. Club leaders will be responsible for any items not picked up by the exhibitors.

The Indoor Exhibits Committee and staff will not be responsible for any exhibits and/or items left on the fairgrounds after the close of the fair.

The Indoor Exhibits Committee and staff is not responsible for loss, damaged or left behind of any exhibits. However, when all possible, precaution will be taken to ensure the safety of the exhibits.
